

MADERA GOLF AND COUNTRY CLUB MEMBER EXPECTATIONS

1. **Required Sign-In:** All players are required to sign in at the Pro Shop before teeing off, including members who live on the course perimeter. All players will tee off on hole #1 unless otherwise authorized by the Pro Shop.
2. **Pro Shop Check-in After Lengthy Off-Course Stops:** If you stop for a sit-down lunch or an extended period of time after nine holes (at the turn), you have forfeited your position and you must check in with the Pro Shop before proceeding to the tenth tee. You may have to wait before space is available. At busy times, the course will be marshaled.
3. **Tee Reservations:** The Pro Shop will take tee reservations one week in advance.
4. **Guest Play:** Each guest is limited to ten visits a year, regardless of whose guest they are, or if they are reciprocal players from another private country club. It is the member's responsibility to ensure that their guests abide by the course rules and dress code regulations. All guests must play with a MGCC member unless authorized by the Pro Shop.
5. **Guest Fees:** Each member is granted 6 guest passes per calendar year. The guest pass covers the green fees only. A cart and range ball fee will be determined by the Board of Directors and will be posted in the Pro Shop. This fee will be paid by the member of the guest by charge, cash, or credit card. Guests not using "guest passes" will pay our normal guest fees which will be determined by the Board of Directors and posted in the Pro Shop.
6. **Women's Golf Club:** Ladies day is every Thursday and their starting times are posted in the Pro Shop. Weekly sign-ups are posted in the ladies' locker room. The third Thursday of the month is Women's Guest Day, except in December and January. When the ladies group is out on the course, the first tee is open for men once the last ladies group clears the first green. You must stay one hole ahead or behind all of the ladies groups when they are having an event.
7. **Dress Code:** All host members are responsible for their guests abiding by the course rules and dress code regulations. The dress code applies to all members, their families, and guests and are in full effect at all times throughout the facility. Golf hats must be worn forward at all times.
Dress Code for Men: No cut-offs. Shorts must be at least mid-thigh in length but not below the knee and no tank tops. No jogging or sweat suits. Mock turtleneck golf shirts and mock collars are acceptable; otherwise, all shirts must have collars for ages 13 and over.
Dress Code for Women: Shorts must be mid-thigh and no midriff tops.
8. **Junior Play:** The Pro Shop staff will regulate all junior play. Tee times will be determined by the Pro Shop if no parent or experienced guest is in the group. No junior will be allowed to drive golf carts without a valid driver's license.

9. **Fivesomes:** Fivesomes are allowed and must keep up with the group ahead of them or be on target for appropriate pace of play. Groups of 5 or more are subject to approval by the Pro Shop.

10. **Play-Through Etiquette:** All players are required to keep up with the group ahead of them. If, for some reason, they have difficulty and fall behind, they shall stand aside and allow all the groups behind to play through. Maintaining a proper place makes it more enjoyable to all players. Groups of two or less do not have the right to play through.

11. **Score Cards:** The scorecards must have the player's first and last names and GHIN number, tees played, and date in order to be posted correctly. All scorecards for nine or more holes must be turned into the Pro Shop for posting. Only the Pro Shop staff may enter scores into the computer. Per the USGA, rounds played as a single player are not allowed as posted scores. Scores eligible to be posted must be from groups of two or more.

12. **Electric Carts:** All electric carts must stay outside of directional cart signs and stay on the cart paths and rough whenever possible. The "H" rule should be observed at all times. Carts must stay on the paths at all times on par-3s. All hand carts must be kept outside the bunkers around the greens and must be kept off all greens and tees. Handicapped members and guests using blue flags must have a handicap plaque issued and MUST stay 30 feet away from all greens.

13. **Course Care:** All players must repair fairway divots using sand bottles on carts and repair ball marks on all greens. Do not retrieve your ball out of the cup with your putter. Replace flagstick carefully so as not to damage the edge of the cup. Sand bunkers must be raked after hitting a shot. Leave the rake on the inside of the bunker and towards the middle.

14. **Tournament Cancellation:** Members who sign up for a tournament and do not participate shall be charged a cancellation fee, equal to the entry fee, unless a 24-hour cancellation notice is given to the Pro Shop staff.

15. **Tournament Payment:** Tournament fees cannot be charged to your account. Cash or check only.

16. **Practicing:** The driving range is open from 7am until 30 minutes before sun down. On Sundays, the range closes early for maintenance. The range tees will be on the grass unless maintenance is being done on the grass tee box. When practicing on the course, please be aware of groups playing so groups aren't held up. Always sand divots and fix ball marks.

17. **Pets:** Pets are allowed if they aren't disturbing golfers, the course, and natural wildlife and the owners clean up after them. If problems occur, the owners will be asked to remove them from the course. No pets are allowed inside the clubhouse.

18. **Carry-On Food/Beverages:** No alcoholic/non-alcoholic beverages or food will be brought onto the premises of the golf course from outside sources. Beverages must be purchased at the restaurant/bar. This applies to outside tournaments as well.

19. **Behavior and Language:** All members are requested to use restraint in their behavior and language. This is a family club and we would like to keep the proper atmosphere for all members and their families.

20. **Rules:** Every member is responsible to abide by these rules. Continued abuse of these rules and regulations could bring Board action.

GREEN FEE POLICY

1. **Members of Private Country Clubs:** Members of another private country club will pay the same rate that their club charges our members when we play at their home club under reciprocal privileges.

2. **Guest Fees:** Guest green fees and guest pass fees are determined annually by the Board of Directors and are posted in the Pro Shop. Guests must play with a member unless approved by the Pro Shop.

3. **Fees Charged:** All member guest green fees and cart charges can be billed to the member account or paid in cash or credit card by the guest. Green fees and cart charges for members of other private clubs can be charged to their home club or paid in cash or credit card.

4. **Medical Leave:** While on medical leave, a member will only have use of the putting green and driving range and the restaurant and bar. No on course play is permitted.

GOLF CART POLICY

1. **Cart Leases:** Monthly rates for single, double, or triple cart leases are determined annually by the Board of Directors and posted in the Pro Shop. Cart lease fees will be suspended during a medical leave. The appropriate cart charge will be assessed if another member or guest rides in a leased or private cart. Cart leases are signed annually, and you may not change cart options once determined.

2. **Cart Rental:** Non-cart lease members and guests of members will pay cart fees per round. These rates are determined by the Board of Directors and posted in the Pro Shop.

3. **Cart Charges:** All cart rentals to guests of members can be charged to the member's account or paid in cash or credit card by the guest. Cart fees for members of other private clubs can be charged to their home club account or paid in cash or credit card.

4. **Monthly Fees:** Monthly Trail Fees apply for carts stored off premises. This rate is determined by the Board of Directors annually and posted in the Pro Shop.

5. **Rider Fee:** There will be a cart fee assessed if a member rides in a private cart. The exception to this is: no fee will be assessed if the riding member has a cart leased on a monthly basis.

6. **Keys:** Cart keys are handed out when you check into the Pro Shop. Upon completion of your round, please return the cart to the return area and leave the key in the cart. Do not take keys home.

7. **Cart Restrictions:** All electric carts must be kept outside of the directional cart signs and on the cart paths around tees and greens. Carts must be kept on paths on all par-3 holes. Members with blue flags must stay 30 feet from all greens.

8. **"H" Rule:** The "H" rule should be observed at all times. All hand carts and kangaroo caddies must be kept outside the bunkers around the greens and must be kept off all greens and tees.
